Committee Reports:

1. Treasurer: \$2,300.00 was transferred from Money Market Savings to Checking to cover past due bills and May's expenses. The Money Market Savings stands at \$4,938.39 after the \$2,300.00 transfer and a \$.30 dividend addition. Treasure's report showed a checking account balance of \$498.80, but appeared to not include all income. A balance based on the bank's figure of \$1,723.80 less known outstanding checks of \$1,075.00 calculated a checking account balance of \$648.80. Further investigation is needed to come up with a complete and accurate report for the next meeting
